

BATLLEGROUP COOKIES POLICY

This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how BATLLE GROUP uses them on their website and how the user can administer them.

1. WHAT IS A COOKIE?

Cookies are small data files that are hosted on the user's computer which contain certain information about the user's visits to the website. The cookie is downloaded by the device used to access the website and is stored on the device's hard drive. Cookies have various utilities, including allowing the website to recognise your device when you visit us again, ensuring that you get the right content, or storing information on services or preferences provided by the user. Cookies do not damage the user's device. In this cookies policy we use the word cookie to refer to all files that store information in this way.

2. DO WE USE COOKIES?

Our website uses cookies in order to collect data that allows us to monitor the usage and usefulness of our website and obtain statistical and security data. The tools used to obtain usage statistics offer the possibility of obtaining an increasingly higher level of detail about the behaviour of website visitors and users. These data can be collected, processed and stored associated to an IP address or a specific user, or they can be scrambled in order to draw conclusions based on anonymous user data.

3. WHAT TYPE OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

Cookies can be differentiated taking into account the different functions which are used, their duration and who manages them. It is important to note that the same cookie can belong to different categories. Below you will find a description of the cookies used in this website.

Analysis cookies

Analytical cookies allow obtaining generic information on user access to the website in order to provide them with aggregate information for statistical purposes. This type of cookies are used to analyse how users navigate the website and monitor its performance. Moreover, the tools used to obtain usage statistics offer the possibility of obtaining an increasingly higher level of detail about the behaviour of website visitors and users. These data can be collected, processed and stored associated to an IP address or a specific user, or they can be scrambled in order to draw conclusions based on anonymous user data. Information collected through cookies may include, among other information, the IP address identifying your computer at any given time, the date and time of access and areas of the website you visit. The purpose for collecting this data is to monitor the use and usefulness of our website for security and statistical purposes.

4. WHAT COOKIES WILL YOU FIND IN OUR WEB SITE?

Below is a list of cookies that can be found on our website:

First name: _ga

Ownership: Google Analytics

Type of cookie: Análisis

Purpose and description: Behaviour and statistical analysis cookie. Enables the unique visitors control feature. This cookie is installed the first time a user enters the website through a browser. When the user enters the site again from the same browser, the cookie will identify the same user. Only if the user changes browser will another access be identified as a different user. Expires 2 years since the last use.

5. HOW CAN I DISABLE AND BLOCK COOKIES?

You can disable or block cookies by activating the setting on your browser, allowing rejecting installation of all or some cookies. If you reject cookies, you may continue using our website, although the use of some services may be limited and as a result your experience on our website may be less satisfactory.

6. HOW CAN I WITHDRAW MY CONSENT?

If you wish to withdraw your consent related to this Cookies Policy, you must delete the cookies stored on your computer through your internet browser's adjustments and settings.

7. HOW DO I MANAGE AND CONFIGURE COOKIES?
